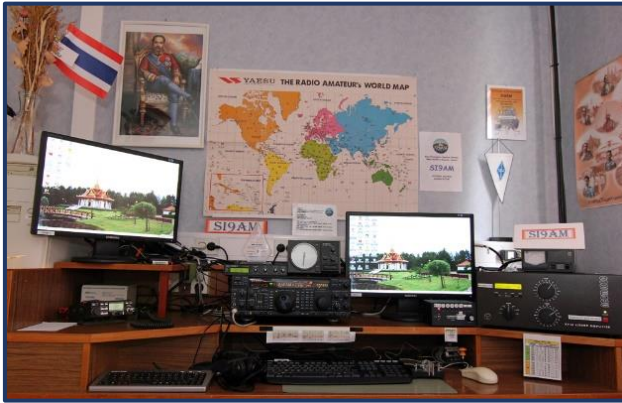


SI9AM - A feeling of Thailand – More than just amateur radio

During the summer there is the "Pavilion terrace" offering, snacks and light dishes. A visit to SI9AM will be a different activity for you or your radio club!

The Dead Falls – Nature reserve with an exciting and interesting story. During the night of 6 – 7 June 1796 Lake Ragundasjön was emptied and disappeared in 4 hours. The 35 meter high waterfall dried out and fell silent for ever – and became "The Dead Falls".
